Video Capsule Instructions with Magnesium Citrate

Things to purchase: One 10 oz bottle of Magnesium Citrate (no red.) This is over the counter in the laxative section of your drug store. No prescription is needed.

1. **The day before your video capsule test**, begin a light diet for breakfast and lunch such as toast and jelly, coffee, juice, soup etc. Avoid high protein or fiber foods to include vegetables and fruit.

2. **After lunch** you will begin clear liquids only. Drink plenty to stay hydrated. You may continue your usual medications until midnight.

3. **At 5:00 pm** the evening before your test, drink the bottle of Magnesium citrate. This is a laxative so be close to the bathroom. Continue on clear liquids.

4. **Do not have anything else by mouth after midnight.** You may take your usual medications **with you** to the hospital. They will instruct you on when you may eat, drink and resume your medications.

- Wear loose clothing such as sweat pants and a button-up shirt.
- **Male patients** should shave the abdomen 6 inches above and below the navel prior to coming to the hospital for your test. This is so the electrode pads can be attached to your abdomen.
- For the test, sensors will be applied to your abdomen with adhesive pads and connected to the data recorder which will be placed in a belt around your waist. After this you will swallow the capsule.
- You will then be released from the hospital with instructions to **return in 8 hours**.

It can take up to 2 weeks for the doctor to complete reviewing the video images. You may call after 14 days for results if you have not heard from the office. We will forward a copy to your regular doctor.

CLEAR LIQUIDS

Water	Soda (diet or regular)
Gatorade and Propel drinks	Italian Ice
Clear broth-any flavor	Juices (Apple, white cranberry etc.)
Bouillon (and flavor)	Jell-O
Coffee, Teas (no creamer)	Popsicles

No Dairy - No Red liquids - No Pulp juices

If desired **one** white wine or **clear** alcoholic beverage on your preparation day is OK.

Be certain you have provided all current insurance information and necessary referrals to our office at least **two weeks** prior to your procedure date. Referrals apply only to HMO and Managed Care plans.
